All staff at the SFL Summer Camp must provide the SFL a current Criminal Record Check.

The SFL covers the cost of your meals and accommodation at Camp. Unfortunately, the SFL cannot pay lost wages of Counsellors while they are at Camp. It is your responsibility to arrange for your union to pay any lost wages you incur. Some Counsellors donate their time to Camp.

If your union is sponsoring your attendance at camp, please ensure that your union has approved your application to Camp before submitting it.
